As we have recently returned from the NEC Meeting out in Indy, the Legislative Commission would like to share some additional information in hopes that you can get this out to the Blue Cap Members. We are attaching several documents to allow easier transfer of information to the membership.

The first attachment is information regarding the George B. Evans Grassroots Veterans' Advocate of The Year Award. This award recognizes a member who has performed outstanding service and made significant contributions of time and effort in Grassroots Veterans' Advocacy work.
