WHEREAS, American Legion Boys State, a highly respected and selective educational program of government instruction for high school students, has been a program of The American Legion since 1935; and

WHEREAS, Objectives of the program are:

2. Arouse a keen interest in the detailed study of government;
3. Develop a full understanding of American traditions and a
